

Grand Canyon Audio Ranger - Instructions for Use

The professionally produced audio tour covers everything from Yavapai Observation Station to the Bright Angel Trailhead, with a few detours to keep you on your toes. The park's geology, human history, wildlife and natural history come alive in the 90 minutes of narration, quotes from rangers and historical figures, and music, making for an enjoyable walk in the park.

Instructions:

1. Unzip the file.
2. Print the accompanying map (audio_ranger_location.pdf) and instruction/stop list (audio_ranger_instruction.pdf) and bring with you to the Grand Canyon.
3. Load the unzipped mp3 files on to your media player of choice.
4. You can listen to the stops in order or pick and choose your favorites and play only those.

Note:

There is no water along the route of the Grand Canyon Audio Ranger on the Rim Trail between Yavapai Observation Station and Grand Canyon Village. Take frequent breaks, and be extremely careful near the edge. When listening to the Audio Ranger, be sure to bring 1 liter (quart) of water per person and sunscreen.
